- **MN Senior Health Options (MSHO)** - MSHO is a service for persons over 65 who are on Medical Assistance (MA). MSHO is a health insurance program. MSHO provides a care coordinator (CC), who is a Registered Nurse, for every person that is on MSHO.
- **Long-Term Care Consultation (LTCC)/MnCHOICES** - MSHO is a service for persons over 65 who are on Medical Assistance (MA). MSHO is a health insurance program. MSHO provides a care coordinator (CC), who is a Registered Nurse, for every person that is on MSHO.
- **Personal Care Assistance (PCA)** - PCA is a service paid for by Medical Assistance. To receive PCA, an assessment is completed by a Public Health Nurse. PCA services can help with such things as Activities of Daily Living (ADLs), health-related procedures and tasks, observation and redirection of behaviors, and Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADLs).

Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP)

- We all want to be healthy, but sometimes we need a helping hand. Thanks to SHIP, our communities are working together to ensure opportunities for good health for parents, kids, and the whole community. The goal of SHIP is to reduce chronic diseases associated with tobacco use and obesity.

Maternal Child Health

- Child and Teen Checkups (C&TC)
 - Child and Teen Checkups staff can help find a doctor or dentist, make an appointment, find transportation, or an interpreter for families with children and young adults on Medical Assistance from birth to age 21.
- Family Home Visiting
 - Home visits support families during pregnancy and after delivery. Staff can provide growth and development checks for infants and children and resources for children with special needs. To apply, call 507-238-4757 and speak to someone in Healthy Families or WIC
- Follow Along Program
 - Keeps track of your child's development from birth - 5 years old. Find out if your child is playing, talking, growing, moving, and acting like other children the same age.
- WIC Nutrition Program
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a nutrition program that offers free nutritious foods and nutrition education to families. If you are pregnant, recently had a baby, or care for a child under age 5, you may qualify for WIC. To apply or for more information call 507-238-4757

This program provides assistance to victims of general crime. The Coordinator assists with criminal justice support, notification of victim's rights, information on charges against the offender, status of the offender, and notifies the victim of court hearings. The Coordinator serves as a link to the prosecuting attorney, shares any concerns the victim may have, assists in explaining plea offers, helps prepare Victim Impact Statements, and advocates for the victim to ensure that their rights as a victim are upheld. The Coordinator assists victims in filing victim compensation claims, coordinates and secures services with other agencies as needed, and provides supportive listening and options available to them based on self-defined needs. There does not need to be a call to law enforcement or criminal charges filed for this program to assist victims.

The Coordinator also escorts victims to court hearings, assists in securing needed services for victims and makes referrals to other agencies as needed.
